During the opening weekend with the CSO, Thibaudet returns with the thrilling flourish of French connection, performing **Gershwin's Concerto in F.** "There's no mistaking [Thibaudet's] understanding of the blues-based melancholy ... his tonal palette illuminating how much Gershwin admired French Impressionism" (*Chicago Tribune*).





This year's gala features a duo of music theater's brightest stars—Tony Award winners Sutton Foster and Kelli O'Hara—joining the Chicago Symphony Orchestra and Ravinia Chief Conductor Marin Alsop to celebrate the transformative impact that even a single musical performance can have on budding minds. Alongside orchestral brilliance, Foster and O'Hara bring an evening of songs that captured their imaginations and proved their mettle as leading ladies—both familiar and not, from theater stages and beyond—to the **Gala Benefit**, which raises funds for Ravinia and its Reach Teach Play music education and community engagement programs.
